Note: The order in which the test steps are listed reflects the sequence of the certification criterion and does not necessarily prescribe the order in which the test should take place.

Required Tests

- (a)(8) Medication allergy list** - Enable a user to record, change, and access a patient's active medication allergy list as well as medication allergy history
- (i) Ambulatory setting.** Over multiple encounters
- Standard(s): None

(i)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The user selects a patient record and accesses the active medication allergies list that has been produced over multiple previous encounters and records a new medication allergy. The user accesses the patient's record for the active medication allergy list, which consists of medications allergies entered over multiple encounters. The user changes/updates the active medication allergy list. The user accesses the patient's record for the medication allergy history, which consists of recorded and changed medication allergies. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The tester verifies the user can access a patient's medication allergy list that has been developed over multiple encounters. The tester verifies the new entry is added to the patient's active medication allergy list. The tester verifies that the changes/updates to the medication allergy list are reflected in the patient's active medication allergy list and the medication allergy history can be accessed.

(ii) Inpatient setting. For the duration of an entire hospitalization.

(ii)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The user selects a patient and accesses the active medication allergy list which includes entries from the entire hospitalization and records a new medication allergy. 2. The user accesses the patient's record for the active medication allergy list, which consists of medication allergies entered over the entire hospitalization. The user changes/updates the active medication allergy list. 3. The user accesses the patient's record for medication allergy history, which consists of recorded and changed medication allergies. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The tester verifies the user can access a patient's medication allergy list that includes the duration of the current hospitalization. The tester verifies the new entry is added to the patient's active medication allergy list. 2. The tester verifies that the changes/updates to the medication allergy list are reflected in the patient's active medication allergy list and the medication allergy history can be accessed.
