

There is more than one XML file with any given measure. Can you please clarify which XML file is the correct one to use for implementation.

Details of the issue:

From the eSpec Navigator, select 'All CQMs' from the Download Links




That gives you the .zip file eCQM-All.zip.

After the contents of the .zip file are extracted, open a folder for one of the measures.

For example, EH_CMS26v1_NQF0338_HMPC_HomeCareDoc

When you open the folder, it contains this xml file:




This xml file has this at the top when you open it:




Note the href string above.

We are not able to import this file. We get an error.

Next, go back to the folder EH_CMS26v1_NQF0338_HMPC_HomeCareDoc.zip



When you open that folder, it contains **this** xml file

Note that the href string is different.

We **are** able to import this file.

I don't know if the href information has any bearing, but there are other differences between the two xml files as well.

Our questions:

Why are there two xml files?

Are you aware that they are different? If so why are they different?

And most importantly, which one are we supposed to use for implementation? This is important because one of them we can successfully import and one we cannot.
