



- IHE SDC Profile is officially published for public comments

IHE SDC Profile Rev1.3 – Change Proposal Overview

- This revision contains updates to SDC Profile based on Connectathon Testing. There are two updates to Volume 1 in Sections X.1.1.2 and X.1.1.3 marked with track changes.
- Volume 3 contains the remainder of the changes, summarized in the bullets below.
 - » Update Form Definition Model
 - Create a more modular Form Definition model that supports complex form structure
 - Within SDC Package, move administrative information, submission rules, and compliance rule at a higher level, outside of XML package for consistency
 - Harmonize and abbreviate element and attribute names
 - » Review and revise the Submit Data transaction details and the related schema document
 - Submit entire form structure rather than simple name-value pair, so that Form Receiver can
 perform additional validation, if needed
 - Harmonize element and attribute names
 - » Editorial Clarifications/guidance
 - Provide additional guidance on HTML and URI transaction
 - Provide examples
 - Suggestions on use of javascripts and other coding languages to support various functionality
 - » Aligned with the new RFD '@responseContentType' in the ITI-34 transaction.






FHIR SDC Profile - Voter Registration
