<p>Conveys Uniform and Integrated Patterns of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Patient Flow – with Patient as Actor • Provider (Work/Process) Flow – with Provider as Actor • Information Flow – including System as an Actor 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Common Actors • Scenarios, Events • Common Actions
<p>Shows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Event Steps with Actions taken – by Actors in Roles – to support individual health and provide healthcare • Health record entries resulting from Actions taken 	

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Shows Patterns of <u>Repetition/Re-Use</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Both Current and Potential 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scenarios, Events • Common Actions
References data objects/elements <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compiled by the Data Element Set Sub-Group • To be superseded by Clinical Element Data Dictionary (CEDD) references when available 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Common Actions • Common Data Objects
Captures Components which may be the (primitive) basis for implementable data and software constructs; e.g., EHR record entries, documents, messages, software "services"	
Is the basis for Core Component registration in the AHRQ (ISO 11179-based) US Health Information Knowledgebase
