## ABOUT US

CMS has initiated the Electronic Medical Documentation Interoperability (EMDI) Initiative with the goal to reduce provider burden, which engages key healthcare stakeholders to participate in pilots to establish secure communication and share medical documentation by using health IT standards and protocols.



## USE CASES



### ORDER

An ordering provider sends an order/referral with other relevant medical documentation to a service/rendering provider.



### ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION REQUEST

The service provider/supplier requests additional medical documentation from the ordering provider.



### SIGNATURE

The service provider/supplier sends a document with a missing physician signature to the ordering provider and requests the ordering physician to sign, date, and return the document.
