FHIR P2 Taskforce Project Charter (lest draft)	 This charter describes an effort convened by The Office of the National Coordinator to address potential solutions to infrastructure/ecosystem barriers that could accelerate HL7 FHIR adoption. Potential barriers include lack of an industry-wide FHIR resource locator, lack of common authentication and authorization approaches to assure appropriate patient privacy, gaps in ability to bridge patient identity across stakeholders, and a lack of industry wide governance and versioning for FHIR APIs. This is important to solve so that clinical data exchange between payers and providers can move more quickly in support of population health, volume to value, and care quality A tiger team approach will be used to solicit wide industry input and develop, catalog and distribute best practices.
