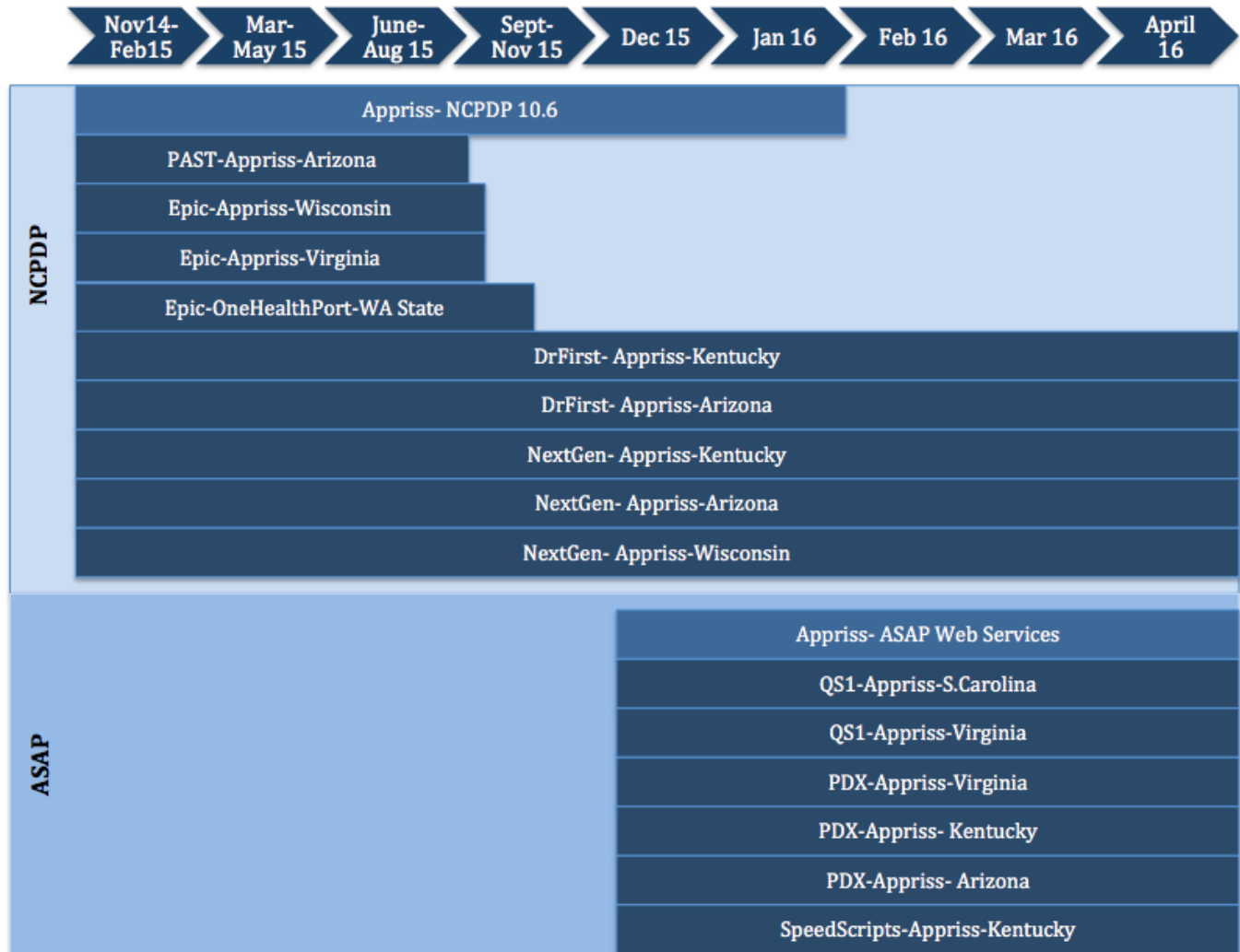

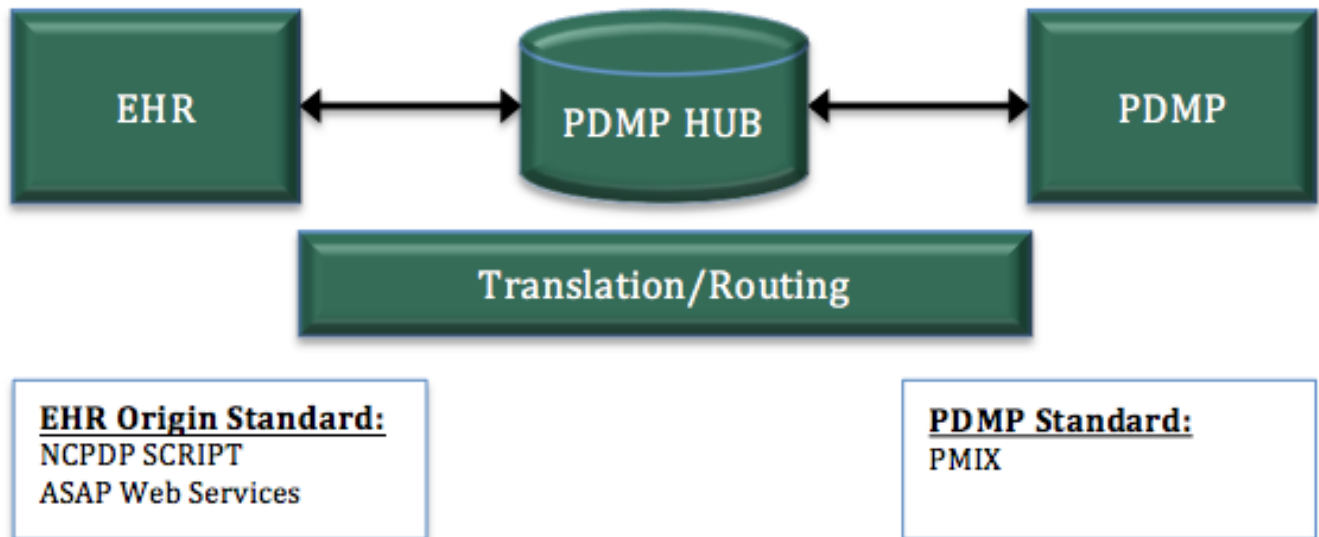
Timeline

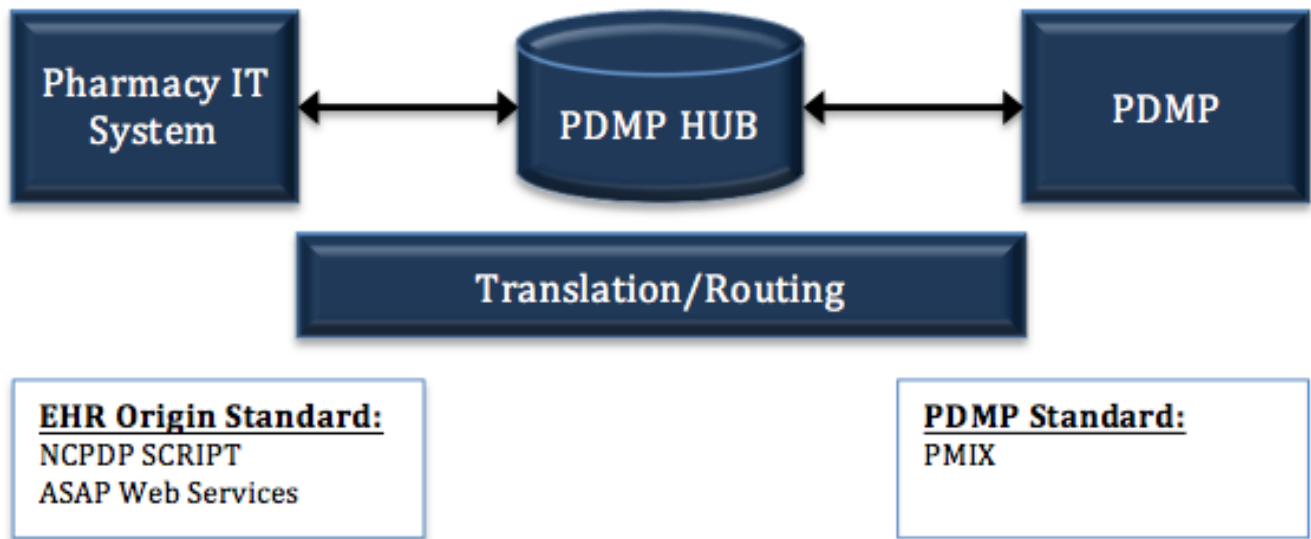
