Installation

The *Tool* is installed from a Linux package. There are two ways to obtain the package. The first is to simply download the latest build of the package from its Apt repository, which is described in the Linux Package Install Guide. The second is to build the package locally as described in the Source Build Guide. It is recommended to download the package from the Apt repository unless there is a specific need to build the source code yourself.
