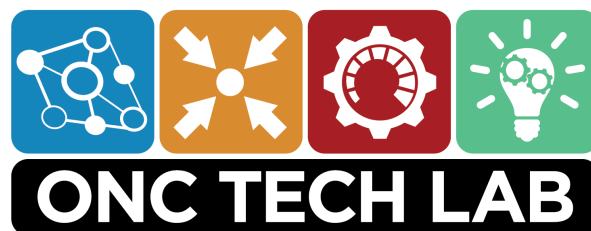


2018 Interoperability in Action Webinar Series #4
